- 1) Who do I contact to bring a Mission Group to Vank Island?

- 2) What is the best way to travel to Vank Island?
  - a. Vank Island is easily accessed from Wrangell Island. You can travel by Alaska Airlines or take the Alaska Marine Ferry Lines, both of which you can book on-line. We can arrange transportation for your group from Wrangell Island over to Vank Island
- 3) What is the best time of year to plan a trip to Vank Island?
  - a. Summer is the high season for most mission trips to our area, but anytime between late April and early October can be arranged.
- 4) Where do mission groups stay while they are working at Vank Island?
  - a. Mission Groups can stay at the church and at Vank Island in the cabins which have bunk beds.
- 5) What facilities are available on Vank Island?
  - a. The campgrounds have a complete kitchen available in the main lodge. All food will have to be brought in by boat.
  - b. There is a fully functioning bath house on the campgrounds (thanks to previous volunteers it is now handicap accessible).
- 6) What are the needs of Vank Island?
